What is Diabetes?

Diabetes is a disease in which the body does not produce or properly use insulin. Insulin is a hormone that is needed to convert sugar, starches, and other food into energy needed for daily life.

Diabetes Statistics

The following information can be found on WebMD.com

- ◆ 7th leading cause of death in US: 23.6 million people in US (7.8% of population) have diabetes
- ◆ Diagnosed: 17.9 million people
- ◆ Undiagnosed: 5.7 million people
- ◆ 11.2% of men and 11.5% of women have diabetes
- ◆ Approximately 1.6 million people, 20 years or older, will be diagnosed this year
- ◆ 16 million people are pre-diabetic patients
- ◆ Diabetes is growing at the rate of 6% per year.

Complications from Diabetes

Eye damage and blindness

- ◆ *Leading cause of new blindness in people ages 20-74*

Kidney disease

- ◆ *Nearly 21% of diabetics will develop diabetic nephropathy*
- ◆ *Leading cause of end-stage renal disease*

Nerve damage and amputation

- ◆ *Up to 70% of diabetics will develop nerve damage*
- ◆ *Most frequent cause of non-trauma amputation*

Heart disease and stroke

- ◆ *Diabetics are up to 4 times more likely to have cardiac events*
- ◆ *Diabetics are 2 - 4 times more likely to have a stroke and heart disease*

Other Factors

- ◆ *Vascular disease*
- ◆ *Tooth and gum disease*
- ◆ *Poor healing of infections/wounds*
