

From Heartland Gatekeeper Orphanage

Dear Church & Ministry Leaders,

As you know the people of Haiti are suffering from the devastating effects of the earthquake this week.

We have been working in Haiti since 1996 and as many of you know we have 51 children in the Gift of God Orphanage in Port au Prince. These children suffered through the floods of September 2008 when they were stranded for 16 days with very little food and water.

Now they are suffering once again as a result of this earthquake. 48 hours after the earthquake we finally received word that they are alive and no one was injured, for which we are deeply thankful and are praising God for sparing their lives.

The situation however, is dire as now their food and water resources are limited and the orphanage staff is severely rationing, knowing that it will yet be days and weeks before food and water distribution lines are set up and safe to get to.

We need your help -

Please pray for the children, staff and directors at our orphanage in Haiti. Security problems will escalate as people in the city become desperate for food and water.

In addition, we need your financial help to buy food, water and supplies for the children. Prices in the country have already skyrocketed. Our directors at the orphanage will need to find food quickly. We also need to begin construction on the replacement facility for the site we lost in the floods of '08.
